This excursion will focus on the original technique of the renaissance sgraffiti in the Southern Bohemia. First, we are going to visit castle in Telč, where we will see an authentic renaissance sgraffito with preserved traces of original trowel shading. After the lunch, we will continue to Slavonice – a renaissance town nearby Austrian border. Most of the burger houses on the main square have renaissance sgraffito façades. It would be possible to see the current condition of facades and hear about some restoration and reconstruction problems and experiences.
